REGISTRATION INFORMATION

ADVISING

Academic advising begins on October 17. Students should meet with their advisor before registering for classes. Registration closes on November 18. During this advising meeting students should confirm that they are scheduled to complete all required course work for graduation. Students registering at the Registrar's Office must obtain the advisor(s) signature(s) on a registration form which is available in Starvaggi Hall.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Go to www.franciscan.edu to use MyFranciscan for online registration. Log on using your student ID number and your personalized password. If you have never before used MyFranciscan and are a current student, your password is the last four digits of your social security number. We recommend you change this password once you login by going to 'Personal Info'.

REGISTRATION

Students begin to register at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 25 based on current class status. Registration closes at midnight on Friday, November 18. Students may register online or at the Registrar's Office by submitting a registration form including an advisor's signature. Registration holds may be placed on accounts for students who have not met with an advisor or who have an outstanding balance. Check your MyFranciscan account for registration holds before registration begins. Registration closes from Saturday, November 19 through Sunday, November 27 before re-opening for the add/drop period on Monday, November 28 at 9:00 a.m. Waitlisting will not be available after November 18.

CLOSED CLASSES/WAITLISTING

Students interested in classes that are closed may place themselves on a waitlist until midnight, Friday, November 18. An alternative course should be selected in the event we are unable to accommodate students on waitlists. All sections of a course must be filled before students are permitted into closed classes. Students are responsible for checking MyFranciscan to see whether their request has been accommodated. Priority may be given to graduating seniors and/or to the order in which students are waitlisted. Beginning no earlier than Monday, January 16 through Wednesday, January 25 a student may petition to enter a closed course by completing a "Petition to enter a Closed Class" form (available at the Registrar's Office) and obtaining the necessary signatures approving entry into the closed class.

CHANGE OF COURSE (ADD/DROP)

Online registration will re-open on Monday, November 28 for the add/drop period. Students may add/drop classes until Wednesday, January 25. After that time, a student who chooses not to take a course must withdraw.

COURSE WITHDRAWAL

Beginning Thursday, January 26 through Friday, March 30 a student who does not want to complete a course may choose to withdraw. Withdraw forms are available at the Registrar's Office and must be signed by the student, the instructor, and the advisor. Resident students withdrawing from all classes must also have the signature of the Director of Residence Life. A grade of withdrawal (W) will be indicated on the transcript. This grade is not calculated into the student's grade point average.

AUDITING CLASSES

Students wishing to audit a course must complete a registration form and obtain both an advisor's and the instructor's signature. 'AU' should be written in the 'Credit' column. The registration form must be submitted to the Registrar's Office before the last day to add/drop classes (Wednesday, January 25). The last day to change a previously registered course to an audit is Friday, February 3. Students who want to audit a class in Gaming must have the approval of Mrs. Zoric, Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs, before departure. The charge for auditing is the same as that for courses taken for credit. Financial aid cannot be used to cover an audit (part time or over 18 credits). The professor reserves the right to require or restrict an auditor's participation in class discussions, examinations, laboratory work and other evaluation procedures. Auditors must attend classes according to the professor's attendance policy for auditors. Auditor students receive a grade of 'AUS', which confers no college credit. Withdrawal from an audited course will be indicated on a student's transcript by the symbol 'AUW'. Those who do not fulfill attendance obligations and have not formally withdrawn from the class will receive an 'AUU' on their transcripts.

REPEATING CLASSES

A student may repeat a course previously taken at the University in which a grade lower than C has been earned. The last grade received will be used to compute the student's grade point average. A course that is retaken will count only once toward graduation requirements. The student's transcript will show both the original grade for the course and the grade earned when the course was repeated. If a student repeats a course at FUS that has taken at another institution, the courses taken at the other college or university will be removed from the transcript.

TUITION INFORMATION

TUITION AND FEES

- Undergraduate full-time tuition rate (\$20,800/per year) is based on 12-18 credits. Students taking more than 18 credit hours will be charged per credit hour for each additional credit. Students taking evening courses are eligible for the evening rate for credits over 18.
- Part time fees are based on 1-11 credit hours (day rate - \$695/credit, evening rate - \$215/credit). A day student enrolled at night who takes 12-18 credits will be charged at the full-time day rate.
- Graduate Counseling, Graduate Philosophy, and Graduate Theology courses cost \$635/credit hour. The Graduate Business rate is \$340/credit hour. Graduate Education is \$255/credit hour. Graduate Nursing is \$400/credit hour.
- A full-time undergraduate junior or senior accepted to a graduate accelerated program, taking a grad level class only pays the full-time undergraduate rate. There is no extra charge for the graduate level class unless the student exceeds 18 credit hours.

TUITION CREDIT FOR DROPPING A CLASS (THROUGH 1/27/12)

- A student who drops from full time to part time will receive the following refund:
- During the add/drop period (through January 25) – 100% adjustment of all tuition charges and financial aid.
- After add/drop through the third week of school (January 26 - February 3) – 80 % adjustment of charges. No change is made to financial aid.
- After the third week (beginning February 6) no refund of charges or changes to financial aid if 1 or more credits are maintained.

TUITION CREDIT FOR WITHDRAWING FROM A CLASS (THROUGH 3/16/12)

A student who completely withdraws from the University will receive the following:

- All charges are prorated depending upon the week until the 9th week of school. No credit after week 9
- All financial aid is returned to the programs first. Refund of student payments are second.
- After the 9th week of school, no refund of student payment is available for a student withdrawal.

STUDENT PRIVACY RIGHTS

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) provides procedures for the appropriate consent for the release of Educational Information about a student. This is applicable to all students enrolled at Franciscan University of Steubenville. **Educational Information** includes grades, academic progress and deficiencies, attendance, class schedules, financial aid, and student billing. This information will not automatically be released, but is available upon request. More information regarding **FERPA**, may be found in the University catalog. Students may sign a release to provide information to their parents or other constituents. Forms are available in the Registrar's Office.

DIRECTORY INFORMATION

At its discretion, the University may disclose directory information in accordance with the provisions of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act to include: student name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, major field of study, dates of attendance, degrees, awards and honors received, the most recent previous educational agency or institution attended by the student, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, height and weight of members of athletic teams, and photographic image.

Students may withhold directory information by notifying the Registrar in writing within two weeks after the first day of class for the fall term. Request for non-disclosure will be honored by the institution for only one academic year, therefore authorization to withhold directory information must be filed annually in the Enrollment Services Department.
