The MA Philosophy Program at Franciscan University of Steubenville invites all scholars working in the area of the early phenomenology to submit abstracts on any topic relevant to the theme of the conference. This encompasses the members of the Munich and Göttingen circles (major and minor figures), their students, their influence, their place within the early period of phenomenology, their relationship to other philosophers, as well as their contributions to the development of the early phenomenology. Papers may cover any relevant philosophical area; logic, ontology, epistemology, intentionality, aesthetics, ethics, etc. Graduate students are welcome to submit proposals. Abstracts should not exceed one page and must be received by email or hard copy by March 20th 2011. Finished papers should not exceed 25 minutes reading time. Conference and meal fees, including breakfasts, lunches, dinner and closing banquet are **waived** for all those presenting papers. The conference fee is otherwise \$75.00 (\$45.00 for students) and is payable at the conference. The meal fee is \$60.00 and is also payable at the conference. The meal fee includes two breakfasts, two lunches, dinner Friday evening, and the closing banquet on Saturday evening.

The conference will begin in the morning on Friday April 29th and will close with an evening banquet on Saturday April 30th. The closest airport is Pittsburgh, PA. A free shuttle will be available from the Pittsburgh airport to the university on Thursday April 28th from 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. and
