



Transient Application for Austrian Program

If you wish to attend classes through the Franciscan University of Steubenville Austrian Program in Gaming, Austria and have credit transferred to the college or university where you are regularly enrolled, you are eligible to apply for admission as a “transient” student using this form. After completing this form, present it to the proper official at the college or university where you are regularly enrolled. If you have not made application to Franciscan University of Steubenville previously, a \$20 application fee is to accompany this form.

You will also need to submit from the college or university that you are now attending:

- An official transcript (in a sealed envelope);
- A letter from the Dean of Students indicating your disciplinary record (in a sealed envelope).

After we have received the necessary documents, your application will be reviewed and you will be notified of the decision. If you are accepted to the Austrian Program, you will then be asked to submit a \$100 deposit to hold your place in the Austrian Program. The deposit is nonrefundable and nontransferable.
